## Maryborough Art Society Inc.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Any entries received not in accordance with the conditions will be hung if space available, however they will not be judged. The Secretary has the authority to move entries into the appropriate section if required. Late entries will not be accepted.
2. Each work must be the original and unaided work of the entrant and must have been completed in the 24 months prior to the competition. All works must be titled. **Titles will be restricted to 20 characters.**
3. For suspension - **All 2D artwork (including Junior Sections) must be ready to hang with LARGE (15mm) "D" rings and sash cord.** All 2D artwork must **not exceed 1.2 m** in any direction including the frame. For the Junior sections artwork must not exceed **1 m** in any direction including frame. Miniature paintings must be a maximum of 100 sq.cm *excluding* the mat and frame.
4. All works (except for Junior Sections) must be for sale. Any artworks sold will be subject to a 25% commission. Each work can be entered in **one section only**. A maximum of six(6) entries per competitor permitted, with a limit of **2 per section**. Diptychs and Triptychs are regarded as one entry, however the overall size must not exceed 1.2 m sq. **Sculptural / 3D artwork is allowed only in Section 9 Sculpture. Entries in the Sculpture Section must be easily lifted by one person.** No Photographs or computer generated "giclee" prints are allowed in any section.
5. **Each piece of artwork is to be clearly marked on the back with the Section, Competitors Name and Address, Title, Medium and selling price.** In the Junior section where work is subject to school assessment the word "School" can be placed in the price column instead of a price. **Artist signature must be covered for judging purposes and will be removed afterwards by stewards for public viewing.**
6. Where as all care will be taken while the artworks are in its charge, The Society does not accept any responsibility for any damage or loss incurred, before during or after the exhibition. Insurance, packaging and freight are the responsibility of the entrant.
7. Any artwork not collected will incur a handling and storage fee. Entries unclaimed or freight not paid within one month of the close of the competition **will become the property of the Maryborough Art Society Inc.**
8. The Judge (s) decision will be final and no correspondence regarding that decision will be entered into.
9. Freight Artwork, a packaging fee of \$10 is applicable and must be included with your entry form.
10. Artwork deemed not acceptable for public viewing will not be hung.
